Lesson 1:	Week 3
Title	Place Value, Addition and Subtraction
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● read and write numerals ● add and subtract multiples of 10.
Mental Warm Up:	<p>Count in steps of 20.</p> <p>Start from 31.</p>
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to work on adding and subtracting in tens.
Educational Challenges	Created differentiated versions of Play 'Bingo'.

Lesson 2:	Week 3
Title	Place Value and Addition
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● add mentally a pair of multiples of 10 ● read and write numerals ● use mental strategies to solve calculations.
Mental Warm Up:	If I want to have a total of 10. Adding and subtracting ideas
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to add tens.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Play 'Collect the tens'. ● Play 'Collect the tens' using two dice 1-6. ● Play 'Collect the tens' without apparatus or hundred squares to help. Start by playing with two dice 1-6.

Lesson 3:	Week 3
Title	Place Value, Addition and Subtraction
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● add and subtract multiples of 10 mentally ● read and write numerals.
Mental Warm Up:	We are going to play bingo again.
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to add and subtract tens, finding quick ways to check the answers.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pretend to be teachers. Make up your own questions and answers. ● Sort out correct / wrong number sentence cards. Make up some of your own. ● Sort out correct / wrong number sentence cards. Make up some of your own for class to solve.

Lesson 4:	Week 3
Title	Place Value and Addition
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● add 10 to a two-digit number ● add a one-digit number to a multiple of 10 ● understand and begin to read '10 more' ● recombine and know what each digit represents.
Mental Warm Up:	Look at these sums - Say if they are right or wrong.
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to add 10 to different numbers.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Work in Pairs. Take a 100 square. Count on 10. Colour in square. What do you notice? ● Continue working on the '10 more monsters' work. ● Work on individual '10 more monsters'. Try with multiples of 10 bigger than 100.

Lesson 5:	Week 3
Title	Place Value, Addition and Subtraction
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● how to add and subtract ● to add and subtract 10 from two-digit numbers ● to solve number problems using + and -.
Mental Warm Up:	Say which number is needed to be added to the number to make 10 or 20.
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to use what we know about adding and subtracting to help us write number sentences.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Make number sentences using a set of number cards. ● Work as a group using the sets of number cards to make a number sentence then record. ● Make number sentences using a set of number cards.

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
