Mental Warm Up:	Number puzzle problems.
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to sort some shapes.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Sort shapes into groups. Draw and name each shape.</li> <li>● Sort the shapes into hoops.</li> <li>● Sort shapes into groups. Draw each shape.</li> </ul>

Lesson 3:	Week 6
Title	Shape and Space
Learning Objective:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● combine squares to make new shapes</li> <li>● understand what makes each shape special</li> <li>● investigate using squares.</li> </ul>
Mental Warm Up:	What do you remember about shapes?
Main Lesson Idea:	Today we are going to investigate different shapes that you can make.
Educational Challenges	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Work with people not in your normal maths group.</li> <li>● Investigate and record the different shapes you can make with the four small squares.</li> <li>● Squares must touch side to side.</li> </ul>

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
