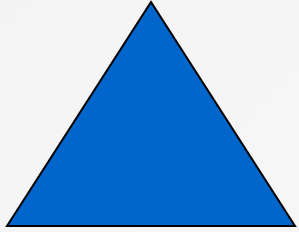
A fair choice

You must choose a number of things to spend your money on at the fair.

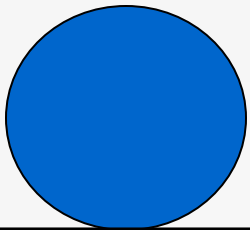
How much will it cost?
