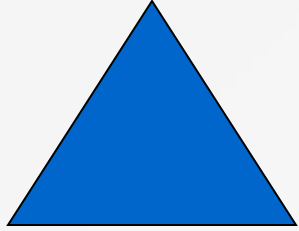

Top Tip

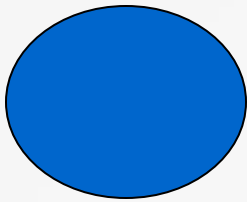
Different words can mean the same thing.
