It is a square in which the numbers in each:

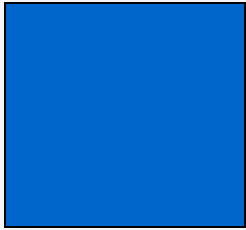
- row

always have the same total.

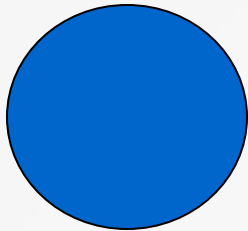

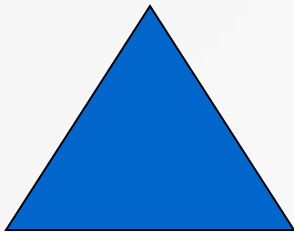
