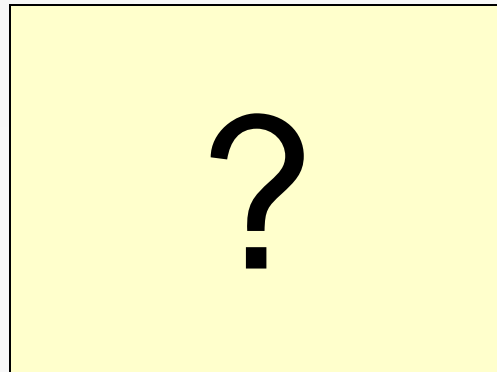
Lesson 3

I am thinking of a pair of numbers with a difference of




What could the answers be?

Main Activity

Today we are going to continue our work
on mass.

How did you find yesterday's task?



Group 1

Work in pairs.

Choose a material.

Estimate which size of plastic bag to put 50g of the substance in.

Group 1

Weigh out the amount.

Were you correct in your choice of bag?

Repeat for other substances.

Group 2

Work in pairs.

Select three or four items.

Estimate what the order of mass should be.

Record the order.

Group 2

Check the order is correct by weighing the items using 10g weights.

Use the words:

- nearly
- a bit more than
- just
- exactly

when finding mass to the nearest 10g.

Group 3

Look at the food packages your teacher has given you.

Which is the heaviest?

Which is the lightest?

Group 3

Draw the packages.

Show the order of mass by marking the lightest with a '1'.

Continue up to the heaviest.
