If it is right, put a 😊 next to it.

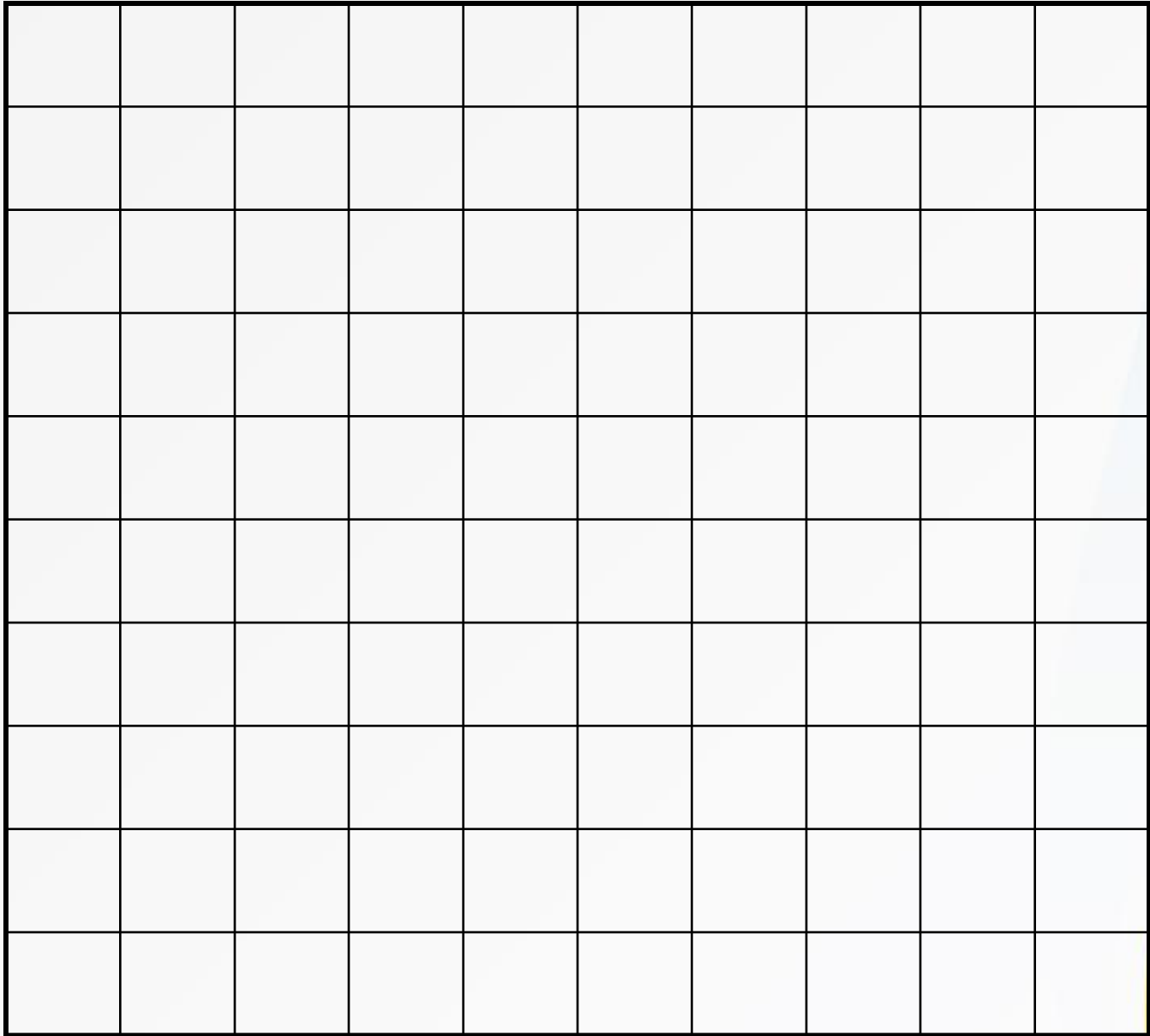
Swap 'leaders'.

knowledge

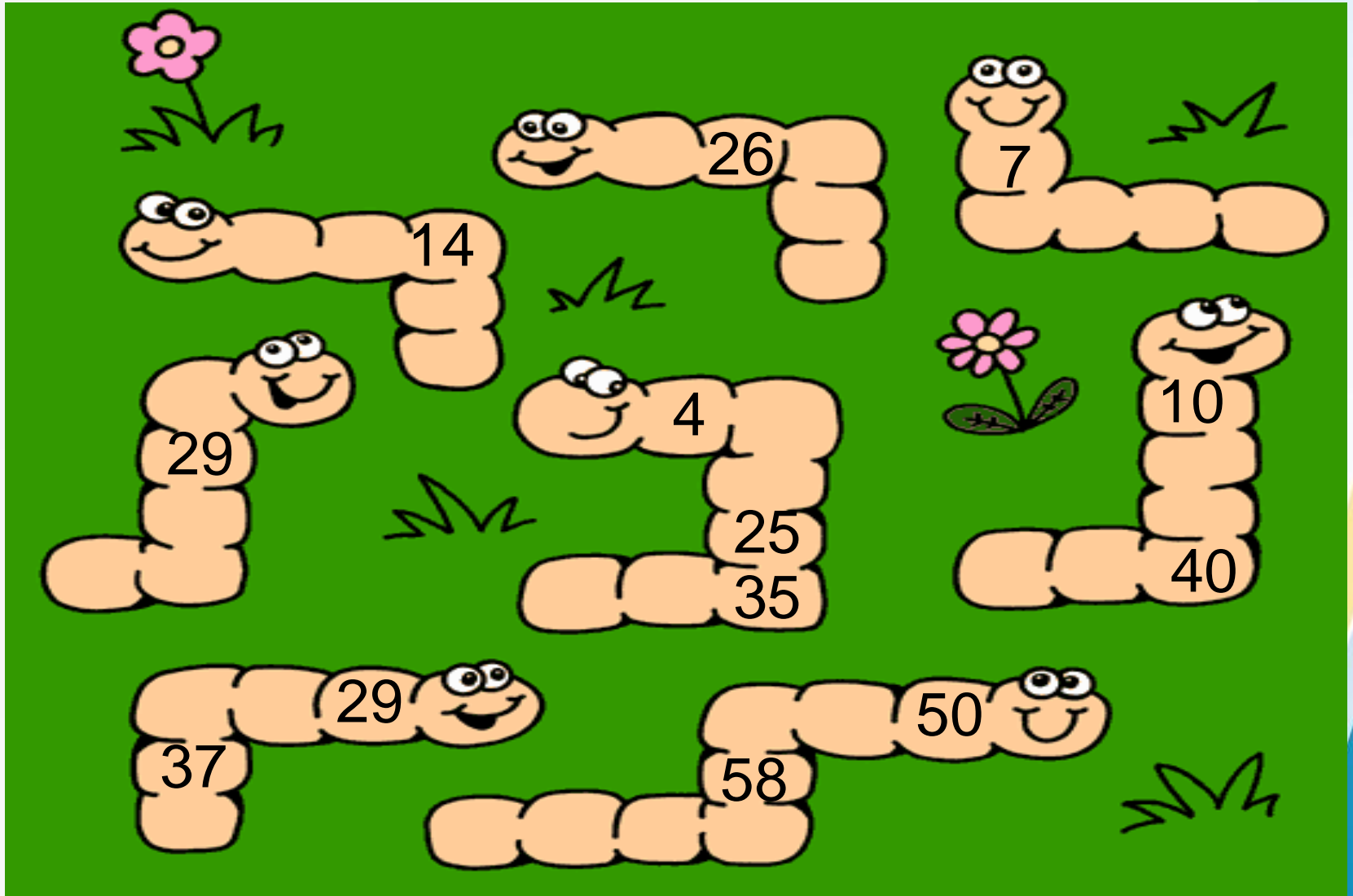
of a hundred square

to work out missing numbers.



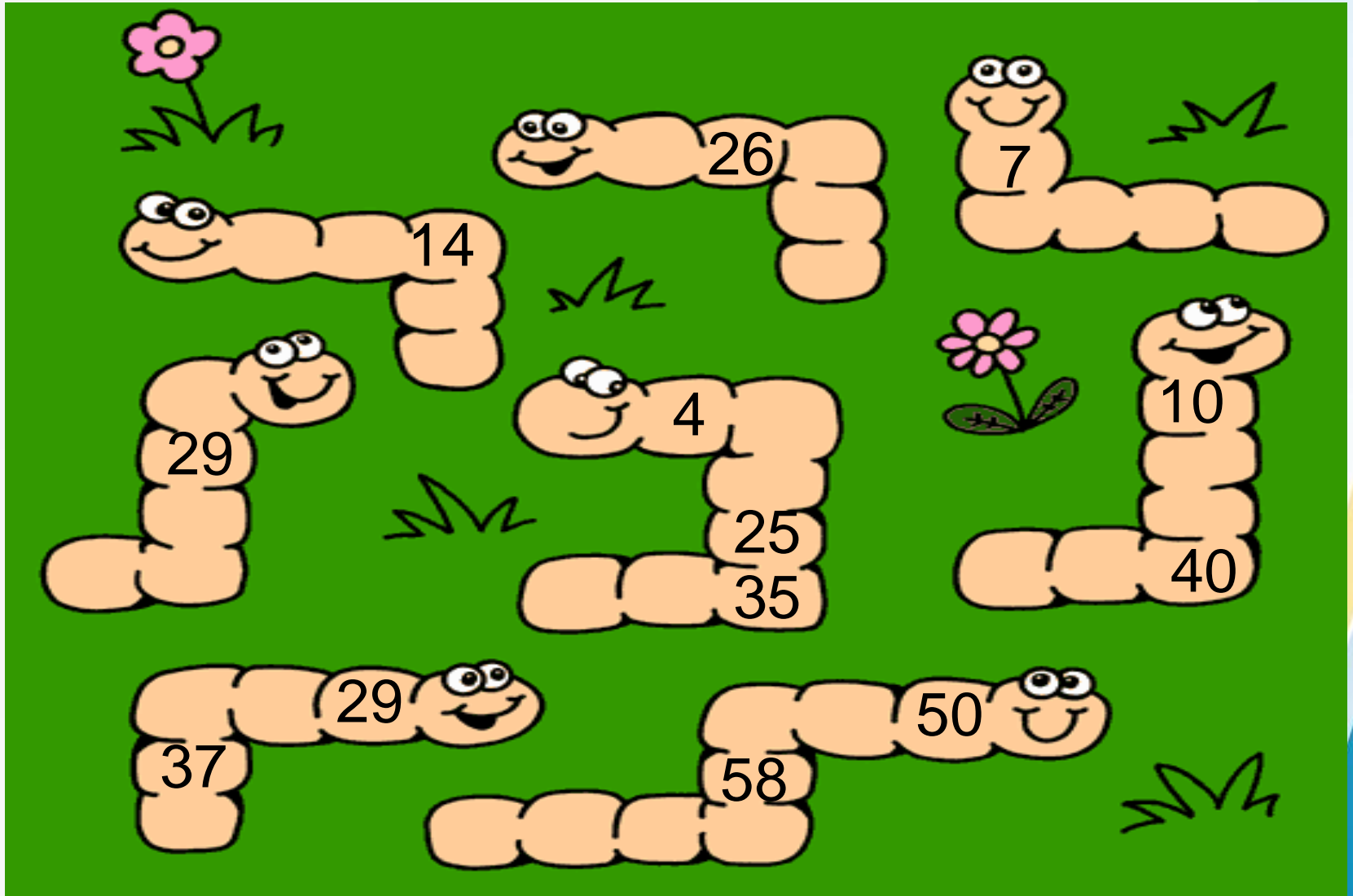
Write in the key numbers on the hundred square such as 1, multiples of 10 and 100.

Wiggly worms



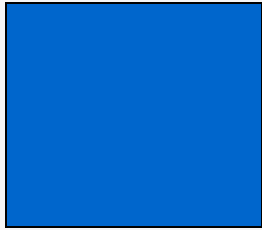
The worms are hiding numbers.

Wiggly worms

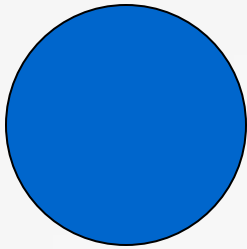


Find the answers on a hundred square.

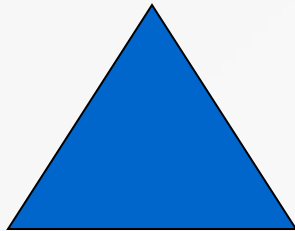
